## **Warm-Ups and Class Preparation**

Instructors must follow the guidelines detailed in the Instructor's Handbook regarding:

- Warm-up routines and physical readiness
- Venue checks and risk assessment procedures

Before any session begins, instructors are responsible for ensuring that the training environment is **safe**, **free from hazards**, **and appropriate for the planned activities**. For detailed procedures on warm-ups and venue preparation, please refer to the **Instructor's Handbook**.

# **Safety Procedures by Age Group**

ZKS Martial Arts recognises the importance of tailoring training approaches to meet the physical and emotional development of different age groups.

To maintain safety and respect each student's developmental stage:

- Training intensity and contact levels must be age-appropriate
- Sparring rules and supervision requirements must be followed precisely
- Correct protective equipment must always be used and checked before training

- Ages 11–16 (Teen Martial Arts)
- Adults (16+)
